## Welcome to Penhalt Farm

The first thing you notice about Penhalt is the sense of open space and clean fresh air. Situated on the Coastal Downs, one mile South of Widemouth Bay.

Our Farmhouse is situated on a rise with splendid views looking out across Widemouth Bay and up the Coastline. It offers a spacious, homely and very comfortable, well-furnished and decorated accommodation.

Keeping part of the ground floor as our working quarters, the accommodation comprises:

### The Flat

- Bedroom 1 - Double aspect with double and single bed and shower.
- Bedroom 2 - Twin beds and hand basin.
- Bedroom 3 - Full-sized pine bunk beds and hand basin.
- Separate toilet, bathroom with a shower and shaver point.
- Large dining room with table to seat ten, lounge suite and TV.



- Fully fitted kitchen, double aspect, electric cooker with ceramic hob, microwave, fridge/freezer, dishwasher and washer/drier.

Some radiators are fed by the owner's Rayburn and hot water is included in the rental price, in addition heating throughout is available by storage heater at no extra charge. There is a coin operated Meter, which accepts £1 coins, for the rest of your electricity needs.

All linen and towels are supplied and pets are welcome for a small charge, if kept under strict control. We can supply a cot, high chair and stair gate.

The enclosed garden has a picnic table and barbecue and the large field in front of the house is ideal for games and kite flying. In the school holidays we may be busy with campers but as visitors are allowed only round the edges of the field there is no obstruction to your view.

There are swings, a small shop, a pool table and telephone on site.

Within less than an hour's drive there are many places of interest to visit including



the historic, picturesque village of Clovelly, the pretty fishing village of Boscastle, Launceston Steam Railway and the Legendary King Arthur's Castle at nearby Tintagel.

There are also several National Trust and English Heritage properties, gardens, nature trails, the Tamar Otter Park and the famous South West Coastal Footpath.

For cyclists there are plenty of quiet country lanes and the breathtaking Camel and Tarka Trails.

The unspoilt sandy beaches of the North Cornish Coast, reputedly amongst the best in the country, offer good surfing and other watersports.

The main beaches are patrolled by lifeguards throughout the holiday season. Dogs are allowed year round on South Beach (Widemouth Bay), Summerleaze Beach (Bude), Duckpool, Sandy Mouth & Northcott Mouth.

On the North Beach (Widemouth), Crooklets (Bude) & Crackington Haven beaches, dogs are not allowed from Easter to 1st Oct.

Local recreational amenities include tennis, golf, riding and a choice of fishing. For families there is the popular 'Splash' Leisure Pool just five miles north in Bude and a popular Ten Pin Bowling Alley.
